What is GeoYukon

GeoYukon is a public mapping and data discovery platform

- Maintained by the Government of Yukon.
- All branches contribute datasets and imagery.
- Most current spatial data for the Yukon.
- Best place to start looking for Yukon spatial data.



Getting started

- Starting GeoYukon
 - Open a browser window and visit yukon.ca/geoyukon
 - Click **View GeoYukon**

View GeoYukon



Layers breakdown

- Land tenure – disposition, licenses, agriculture, surveyed land, easements, historical
- First nation layers – territories, settlement land, surveyed/non surveyed, core areas
- Elevation – terrain annotation, spot height, contours, hypsometry, shaded relief
- Imagery – air photos (historical), ortho imagery, satellite imagery (low, med, high)
- All can be viewed in GeoYukon and added to a map



Imagery

- Footprints polygon layer used to determine if and what kind of coverage exists
- Aerial, High and Medium resolution available
- Satellite imagery can be viewed only in GeoYukon
- Most aerial imagery can be downloaded
- Satellite imagery is licensed for internal use only
- SPOT 6/7 – 2014-2016 mosaic available for viewing

Visualization and labels

- **Visualization**
 - Can be turned on/off
 - Custom visualization can be customized
- **Labelling**
 - Can be turned on/off
 - Choose an attribute to display in viewer
 - Font size, style and position
 - Custom or premade styles available
- **Add text to map**
 - Custom text can be added to maps

Saving and opening projects

- Sign in using district office sign in credentials
- Saving projects saves – view, labels, visualization and any drawings.
- Useful for repetitive processes/tasks
- Saves indefinitely or until manually deleted
- Save as for new project or save to overwrite existing.

Exporting Images and maps

- Export map: view and map elements exported – layout, legend, title, summary etc.
- Export view: only map view is exported
- Choose your desired extension and save as
